Dr. John Taylor received his Bachelor of Science in Biology at the University of Pittsburgh in 1994. He then completed medical school at the Ohio College of Podiatric Medicine with Honors in 1998. He received the Mildred A. Kaufmann Award for Proficiency in Foot Biomechanics and Orthopedics upon graduation. His residency consisted of two years Primary Care, Surgery and Wound Care in El Paso and Cleveland.

Before joining Pittle Podiatry, Dr Taylor, provided and co-directed a Wound Care Clinic at the Veterans Health Administration in El Paso for four years.

Dr Taylor is Board Certified with the American Board of Podiatric Surgery and is a Diplomat of the American College of Foot and Ankle Surgeons. He is a Fellow of the American Professional Wound Care Association and a member of the American Podiatric Medical Association.
